Notice is hereby given that the El Cerrito City Council will conduct a public hearing in the Council Chambers, located at El Cerrito City Hall, 10890 San Pablo Avenue, Tuesday, June 18, 2019 at 7:00 p.m., or thereafter, to consider an Ordinance Amending Chapter 13.28 Of The El Cerrito Municipal Code, Trees And Shrubs.

In order to protect and maintain the health of the publicly controlled Urban Forest, the City is proposing an update of the El Cerrito Municipal Code, Chapter 13.28, relating to Trees and Shrubs. The amended language would establish: maintenance standards to protect public trees; penalties for damaging or killing a public tree; processes for tree planting, pruning, and removal; processes for enforcement and appeals of violations; and amended language to clarify the City's policies and regulations relating to the management and protection of public trees and shrubs.
