Together with your school and PTA, The El Cerrito Recreation Department coordinates with professional instructors, coaches and organizations to host classes held conveniently after school on the Fairmont campus. We strive to offer a program that allows students to discover and develop their passions in chess, art, athletics, science and more!

2. Beginning 1/2/19 registration forms and payment of course fees can also be submitted directly to the El Cerrito Community Center at 7007 Moeser Ln, El Cerrito, 94530 (open M/W every other F, 8am-4pm, T/TH 8am-6pm). Please complete one form per child. Registration forms are available at the El Cerrito Community Center, Fairmont Elementary School office, or online at <http://el-cerrito.org/146/Enrichment-Classes>. Write one check for all FASEP course fees payable to "City of El Cerrito." Cash and Credit Card are also accepted in-office.
3. Email [recreation@ci.el-cerrito.ca.us](mailto:recreation@ci.el-cerrito.ca.us) or fax (510) 528-9413 registration forms with credit card authorization on or after 1/2/19.
4. Registration is only accepted online or at the Community Center. DO NOT submit any registration forms or fees to the Fairmont School office or Fairmont Clubhouse as they will not be processed.
5. Registration will be open for all at the same time and is first come, first served. All classes have varying minimum and maximum enrollment sizes. Classes may be subject to cancellation if minimum enrollment number is not fulfilled. You will receive a full refund if a class is cancelled due to low enrollment. A waitlist will be maintained for classes that fill to their maximum enrollment.
6. Whether completing the registration process online or via the registration form, all registrants will be asked to agree to the FASEP Policy Statement and Waiver. Please review these policies carefully, as they contain important information on check-in, pick-up, materials fees, refunds, inclement weather procedures and more.
7. If applicable, Materials Fees must be paid separately, written and paid directly to the FASEP course instructor by the first day of class. Failure to pay materials fee by the 3<sup>rd</sup> class may result in dismissal from class with no refund of the paid course fee.
8. Fairmont Aftercare students must check in at the Fairmont Clubhouse or MPR prior to their FASEP class. City Staff will escort them to their FASEP class. All other students must check in directly with the class instructor.  
**Note about FASEP Kindergarteners:** *The K bell rings notably earlier than FASEP class start times. Kindergarteners enrolled in the PMKC program will be escorted to and from FASEP classes by City Staff. Kindergarteners who are only enrolled in the Fairmont Aftercare PMK program or who are not enrolled in the Fairmont Aftercare program at all must be escorted to and picked up from their FASEP class by a parent/guardian. Pick up must happen right at the class end time.*

## **MONDAY**

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### **SCULPT & SKETCH:** LISA DIPRIMA

GRADES: K-2

Young artists will work with a variety of media including mexoclay, plastiline, paper and sculpey to create sculptures that reflect their life and times. Participants are given gentle instruction and are encouraged to work freely and independently. Vivid imaginations required! **\$25 Materials Fee due on the first day of class.** Materials Fee will be used for clay, plastiline, tempera paint and other art supplies.

### **OYC MIRACLE CHORUS:** OAKLAND YOUTH CHORUS

GRADES: 1-6

Oakland Youth Chorus (OYC) is an award-winning multicultural music education program. Each week singers build musical skills including melody, rhythm, harmony and theory with age appropriate activities in an encouraging and fun environment. Through performing in class and at optional OYC concerts at venues like Oakland Zoo Lights and Children's Fairyland, OYC members make new friends, celebrate different cultures and styles of music, and create harmony. ## **TUESDAY**

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### **ROBOTED: MEDIEVALBOTS!:** TINY TECHS CLUB

GRADES: 1-4

Travel back into history with Robotics! Build tools, fortresses and machines from the Middle Ages and program them to be robots. Learn the fundamentals of engineering like gears, levers, pulleys and cranks. Spin the Ninja Star and pull up the Drawbridge. Launch the Catapult and breakdown with the Battering Ram! Each team of two gets a computer and a LEGO® WeDO® kit to use. This class provides an exclusive curriculum with emphasis on hands-on work, STEM concepts and fun with science and LEGOS.

## **WEDNESDAY**

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### **SUPER SOCCER STARS JR.:** SUPER SOCCER STARS

GRADES: K-1

With Super Soccer Stars, the goal is to teach soccer skills in a fun, non-competitive, and educational environment. The philosophy is to use soccer to nurture, build self-confidence, and develop teamwork in every class. Coaches use positive reinforcement and a low child-to-coach ratio to help each player improve at their own rate while having fun. **\$15 Materials Fee due on the first day of class.** Materials Fee will be used for Super Soccer Stars T-Shirt (optional for returning participants).

### **INTRODUCTION TO MANDARIN:** LILY ZHONG

GRADES: 2-6

This is a conversational class where students learn Mandarin through group conversations, games, songs and videos. This class will increase understanding of Chinese culture and improve Mandarin speaking and listening skills. **\$10 Materials Fee due on the first day of class.** Materials Fee will be used for stationary, worksheets and small prizes.

## **THURSDAY**

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### **DANCING AROUND THE WORLD:** LEILA HALSBAND

GRADES: K-3

People have always used their bodies to express themselves, connect with others and get energized. However, each culture does this in its own way and has something unique to teach us. Students will learn the basics of different dances around the world. What they share is the beauty of movement and joy! This class is a great workout that improves coordination, self-esteem and teamwork.

**CREATIVE THURSDAYS: LISA DIPRIMA**

GRADES: 2-6

Children's imaginations will blossom in this nurturing, appreciative mixed media art class. They will paint, draw and create clay and plastiline sculptures as they experience the joy of color, line and form. Participants are given gentle instruction and are encouraged to work freely and independently. **\$25 Materials Fee due on the first day of class.** Materials Fee will be used for color pencils, clay, paper, plastiline, markers, watercolors and tempera paint.

**FRIDAY**

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**FUN ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE: VERONICA MEDINA-ROSS**

GRADES: 1-4

Students will learn about the environment around them with new hands-on experiments and fun activities. They will learn about ecosystems and how human activities have affected them. For example, we will review the concept of healthy habitats and food chains and do new experiments and activities related to these concepts. We will learn characteristics of specific habitats like oceans and forests. We will learn about the importance of clean water and do experiments to purify polluted water and clean "oil spills." At the end of the program, students will be aware of ways to protect our planet. **\$15 Materials Fee due on the first day of class.** Materials Fee will be used for science experiment and take-home materials.

**CHESS CLASS: BERKELEY CHESS SCHOOL**

GRADES: 1-6

Chess is fun and can be learned quickly and easily! Studies have found that chess helps improve test results in reading, science and math. It also helps with cognitive skills, academia, self-esteem, respect for others, patience and good sportsmanship. Boards and sets are provided for students.

**Scholarships Available!**

The City of El Cerrito's **David Hunter Youth Memorial Scholarship Fund** is available to families in need of financial assistance. This covers a maximum of 75% of course fees, not to exceed \$150 per year, per child. Applications are available at the El Cerrito Community Center or online at [www.el-cerrito.org/scholarship](http://www.el-cerrito.org/scholarship).

In addition to the DHY Scholarship, additional funds are offered to Fairmont students from the **Fairmont PTA FASEP Scholarship Fund**. Applicants must first apply to the David Hunter Youth Scholarship (above), and after reaching the \$150 annual limit, up to an additional \$100 may be awarded by the Fairmont PTA.

Please note that the Fairmont PTA FASEP Scholarship is only offered to Fairmont students.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Behavior Policy:** Participants are expected to follow the El Cerrito Recreation Department Behavior Policy as well as all rules established by the class instructor and Fairmont School. Failure to comply may result in dismissal from the program. No refunds will be given in such instances. A copy of the full El Cerrito Recreation Department Behavior Policy is available upon request (email recreation@ci.el-cerrito.ca.us).

\_\_\_\_\_ **Check In:** Participants enrolled in a FASEP course on the same day as Fairmont City Aftercare must check-in with City Staff at the Clubhouse prior to going to their FASEP class. City Staff will escort childcare students to their FASEP class. Non-City Aftercare students must check directly into the class.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Injury:** Participants in the City of El Cerrito programs participate at their own risk and the City does not provide accident insurance.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Late Pick-up Fee:** Parents/Guardians are responsible for picking up participants at class dismissal unless they are enrolled in the Fairmont City Aftercare Program. A late fee of \$1 per minute will be charged after a 5-minute grace period. Any time there is a delay in picking up a child, they will be taken to the City Aftercare program located in the Fairmont Clubhouse. Persons picking up the child will be asked to pay the late pick-up fee at the time of pick-up and sign a late pick-up slip.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Materials Fee:** Parents/Guardians are responsible for paying any Materials Fee directly to the instructor by the FIRST DAY OF CLASS (or brought to the El Cerrito Community Center in a separate envelope stating "MATERIALS FEE" with the instructor, student, and class name). **Failure to do so by the third class may result in dismissal of my child from the program with no refund of course fees.**

\_\_\_\_\_ **Minimum Days:** FASEP classes generally do not meet on scheduled minimum days that do not fall on a Wednesday. Exceptions to this will be noted in the registration packet.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Photos:** I acknowledge that the City of El Cerrito takes photographs and videotapes of its activities and events for publicity purposes and authorize the use of my image or my child's image by the City for such purposes. I understand I will not be compensated for use of photos or videos.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Refunds/Transfers:** There are no refunds or transfers for FASEP activities unless a medical emergency occurs with a doctor's note or the activity is cancelled due to low enrollment. For class dates cancelled due to inclement weather or instructor emergencies, credits will be applied to accounts prior to the end of the session.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Returned checks:** I understand that there is a \$25 fee charged for returned checks.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Cancelled Classes & Rainy-Day Policy for Outdoor Classes:** In the event of rain or other poor weather conditions, outdoor classes may be cancelled. Similarly, if an instructor has an emergency and cannot provide a substitute, class may be cancelled. Some classes have special "no class" dates scheduled in advance and these dates are stated on the FASEP calendar. Parents/Guardians must be prepared to pick up participants after the regular school dismissal time on such days (unless enrolled in the City Afterschool Program). For cancellations not included on the calendar, you will be notified via phone and/or email using the contact information provided on this form. Parents may also call the El Cerrito Recreation Department at (510) 559-7000 on the day of class to confirm whether class will be cancelled due to poor weather (typically determined after 12pm).

## David Hunter Memorial Youth Scholarship Application

The City of El Cerrito offers a limited number of scholarships supported by donations for its recreational and childcare programs to assist families in need of providing safe, high quality recreation and childcare programs for their children.

### SCHOLARSHIPS:

Scholarships are offered in the form of a reduced payment for recreational classes, programs and after-school enrichment classes and for childcare.

Childcare/Preschool Programs: children may receive reduced hourly rates based on information provided (see below). For childcare programs, provide a copy of free or reduced lunch letter from WCCUSD.

Non-Childcare Programs: Scholarships granted may not exceed \$150.00 per child one year from the initial award date for after-school enrichment and recreation classes. If funds are available, at the discretion of the Recreation Department Director, a higher amount may be granted to a single family.

***You must pay a minimum of 25% co-payment for each activity or class that you sign-up for.***

### APPLICATION PROCEDURES:

To apply for a scholarship, fill out the attached form and submit **one** of the following options:

1. Proof from the school district that your child is eligible for free or reduced price meals
2. Proof that your family is receiving Food Stamps, CalWORKS assistance, or TANF (Temporary Aid to Needy Families)
3. Proof that the child is a foster or institutionalized child
4. A copy of your last Federal Income Tax Return showing that you fall under the following income eligibility guidelines (Federal Income Eligibility Guidelines – Reduced price meals):

# Fairmont After School Enrichment Program PTA Scholarship Form



The Fairmont PTA offers scholarship assistance to Fairmont students who otherwise might be unable to attend FASEP classes. The reimbursement can be put back on your credit card or be applied as a credit on your account to be used toward other City of El Cerrito Recreation Department programs.

\_\_\_\_\_ If registering in person at the El Cerrito Community Center, scholarship funds can be applied at the time of registration. Families will pay a minimum co-pay of 25% of the FASEP course fees.
