

RETIRED OFFICER CONCEALED WEAPON ENDORSEMENT RANGE QUALIFICATIONS APPROVAL FORM



In accordance with El Cerrito Police Department Policy 220 all retired peace officers are required to qualify annually with the authorized firearm at a course approved by this department at the retired officer's expense. Upon verification by this department that all annual requirements have been met by an otherwise qualified retired officer, the "CCW Approval" endorsement shall be permitted.

1. 3 YARD LINE – PRESENTATION FROM HOLSTER – 3-4 ROUNDS – REPEAT DRILL	YES <input type="checkbox"/>	NO <input type="checkbox"/>

Officer will draw weapon from holster and fire three to four rounds. Officer will holster weapon and repeat drill a second time. No time limit, however, officer should complete drill as fast as he/she can shoot accurately.

2. 7 YARD LINE – FAILURE DRILL – 3 ROUNDS – REPEAT DRILL	YES <input type="checkbox"/>	NO <input type="checkbox"/>

Officer will draw weapon, firing two to three rounds into the upper chest area on the target. The officer will then fire one round into the head of the target. The officer will repeat the drill. Again, no time limit, however, this drill should also be shot as fast as the officer can shoot accurately.

3. 10 YARD LINE – STANDARD RESPONSE 4 ROUNDS (POSITION OF YOUR CHOICE)	YES <input type="checkbox"/>	NO <input type="checkbox"/>

Officer will shoot four rounds, in a position of their choice. (Standing, kneeling or prone) – 30 SECONDS.

Officer will shoot an entire magazine. This drill is not scored; however, the officer should have all hits on the target. Officers are encouraged to continue training until they can shoot an entire magazine with no misses – No time limit

HITS FROM DRILLS 1-3 MUST BE IN THE A, B, OR C BOX OF A USPSA – IPSC TARGET OR CENTER MASS AREA OF SIMILAR TARGET. Safety and competency with handling the firearm must be demonstrated by the Officer.
