Special circumstances call for special camps, and Recreation Staff are thrilled to be able to provide them! These 3-week long camp sessions with maximums of 12 children will spend most of their time outside in nature with the same group of friends and staff that will be both socially distant and enable greater building of friendships. Join with your friends for the same camp experience. Parents can choose a grade-specific camp or a mixed grade K-6 camp that will keep siblings together (this is highly recommended where feasible to keep households contained as much as possible). All camps will engage in arts and crafts, outdoor games, science, nature, yoga, dancing, and activities that are designed to keep the brain growing and learning math and language as well. Each longer day option will incorporate a silent reading time in the afternoon. Scooter days and water days are a couple of examples of some of the fun you will see at these camps. Each camp will create their own camp name and participate in weekly themed activities filled with spirit!

El Cerrito Sports Camp Special Session for 1st-8th Grade

In this 3-week long camp session, campers will bond with their pod of 12 or fewer campers through all outdoor games and activities. Each pod will have its own home base that includes a canopy, tables and chairs. Sets of sports and games equipment will be provided to each pod including items such as bats and balls for T-ball and batting practice, basketballs for shooting practice and games of HORSE, soccer balls for passing and shooting practice, hula hoops, Frisbees, dodge balls, art supplies, LEGO and Jenga Bricks, kick balls, kites, Foosball, Chess, Connect 4 and more. Campers will also participate in obstacle courses, races, water balloon tossing, and an occasional nature walks and treasure hunts. There will be no playground use or pool visits during this special session.

While families are welcome to choose the time slot that best fits their needs, we are recommending the Early pod for grades 1-2, the Mid pod for grades 2-4, and the Late pod for grades 4-8.

All prices and locations subject to change. Camps subject to cancellation if minimum enrollment requirements are not met (in which case a full refund will be provided). For this special session, all in-person camps require a three-week commitment. No cancellations or transfers will be permitted during the special session except for medical reasons. Families will receive a camp packet prior to camp that includes information on special drop-off and pick-up procedures, daily temperature check requirements, and more. All camps will adhere to strict drop-off and pick-up windows to stagger congregation. Camp Staff will receive specific training and instruction on sanitizing equipment/facilities and use of personal protective equipment. Separate camps will not mingle, even if they are sharing a site. Some sharing of equipment will occur but be contained to individual pods.
