Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis and is required for all camps prior to participation.

If you miss the **reCexpo** remember to register early as some camps fill quickly or may be cancelled prior to the first camp day due to low enrollment.



FEES AND MATERIAL FEES

The fees listed are Resident and Non-Resident rates. Fees are subject to change. Material Fees are paid directly to the instructor on the first day of camp. If a class does not indicate a Material Fee, a supply list may be discussed at the first meeting.

CAMP REFUNDS, CANCELLATIONS & TRANSFERS

Requests for cancellations and transfers must be submitted in writing (email OK) to the El Cerrito Community Center Office or processed online at <https://web2.vermontsystems.com/elcerrito.html> under "My Account" no later than 10 working days prior to the first day of class/camp.

Cancellations and transfers will not be granted for non-attendance. Camp cancellations prior to 10 working days will result in cancellation fee of \$30. Transfers are assessed a fee of \$17 per child per camp/class.

In the case of illness or injury, requests for a refund, transfer or credit will be considered only when accompanied with a doctor's note and letter requesting the exception.


